- 10 There shall be printed on the ballot to be used at this election the title of this Act and
- 11 underneath the title, on separate lines, a square or box opposite the words "For a
- 12 Board of Education to be Partly Elected by the Voters of Anne Arundel County and
- 13 Partly Appointed by the County Executive" and a corresponding square or box
- 14 opposite the words "For a Board of Education Appointed by the Governor". A voter
- 15 may choose only one of the methods of selection. If a majority of the votes cast on the
- 16 question are "For a Board of Education to be Partly Elected by the Voters of Anne
- 17 Arundel County" the provisions of this Act shall become effective on the 30th day
- 18 following the official canvass of votes for the referendum, but if a majority of the votes
- 19 cast on the question are "For a Board of Education Appointed by the Governor" the
- 20 provisions of this Act are of no effect and null and void.
- 21 SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
- 22 of Section 6 of this Act and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum
- 23 required by Section 6 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006.
