- 2 Creation of a State Debt Anne Arundel County Bell Branch Supplemental Field Lighting
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- \$450,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- 6 Crofton Athletic Council for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 7 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; establishing a deadline for the
- 8 encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for
- 9 the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

## 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Bell Branch
- 14 Supplemental Field Lighting Loan of 2006 in the total principal amount of \$450,000.
- 15 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
- 16 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 17 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance
- 18 and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 26 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 27 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Crofton
- 28 Athletic Council for planning, design, construction, reconstruction, installation, and
- 29 capital equipping of athletic field lighting at Bell Branch Park and Athletic Facility,
- 30 located in Gambrills.

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 5 (5) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 6 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2013. If any
- 7 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 8 2013, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 9 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 10 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 11 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 June 1, 2006.
