9 (w) "Public service company" means a common carrier company, electric

10 company, gas company, sewage disposal company, STEAM HEATING COMPANY,

11 telegraph company, telephone company, water company, or any combination of public

12 service companies.

13 (GG) "STEAM HEATING COMPANY" MEANS A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY THAT 14 MANUFACTURES, SELLS, OR DISTRIBUTES STEAM FOR USE, SALE, OR DISTRIBUTION. 15 4-401.

16 As it considers necessary, and in accordance with the requirements of § 4-402 of

17 this subtitle, the Commission may allow a gas company, STEAM HEATING COMPANY,

18 or electric company to establish a sliding scale to adjust costs of its fuel, purchased
