## 2 Prince George's County - Greenbelt Community Center Loan of 2001

- 3 FOR the purpose of amending the Prince George's County Greenbelt Community
- 4 Center Loan of 2001 to alter the purpose of the loan and the amount of the
- 5 matching fund required; and generally relating to the Prince George's County -
- 6 Greenbelt Community Center Loan of 2001.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 8 Chapter 124 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001
- 9 Section 1
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 12 Chapter 124 of the Acts of 2001

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 16 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 17 George's County [Springhill Lake Recreation] GREENBELT COMMUNITY Center
- 18 Loan of 2001 in [a] THE total principal amount [equal to the lesser of (i) \$300,000 or
- 19 (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below]
- 20 OF \$300,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 21 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 22 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 23 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 24 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 25 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 26 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 27 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 28 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 29 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of the City of
- 4 Greenbelt (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the repair[,
- 5 renovation, and reconstruction of the existing Springhill Lake Recreation Center and
- 6 for the construction and capital equipping of an addition to this facility] AND
- 7 REPLACEMENT OF WINDOWS IN THE HISTORIC PORTIONS OF THE GREENBELT
- 8 COMMUNITY CENTER, INCLUDING REMOVAL OF LEAD PAINT AND REPAIRS
- 9 ASSOCIATED WITH WINDOW REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT, LOCATED in Greenbelt.
- 10 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 11 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 12 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 13 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 14 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 15 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 16 matching fund OF \$200,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
- 17 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 18 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or funds expended
- 19 prior to the effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of in-kind contributions.
- 20 In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets
- 21 may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter
- 22 and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, [2003] 2007, to
- 23 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 24 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 25 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 26 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 27 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 28 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 June 1, 2006.
