A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County - Dissolution of a Nonprofit Organization and Creation of a**
3 **Sanitary District**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain nonprofit organization established for
5 operating a public water system in Calvert County may petition the Secretary of
6 the Environment to convert to a sanitary district; providing that a vote on a
7 certain petition shall be conducted in a certain manner; specifying the contents
8 of a certain petition; requiring the Secretary to file a certain notice of conversion
9 with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation under certain
10 circumstances; providing that a certain nonprofit organization shall cease to
11 exist and all assets, liabilities, and bylaws of the nonprofit organization shall
12 become the assets, liabilities, and bylaws of a certain sanitary district; providing
13 for the membership, terms, and duties of a certain sanitary commission;
14 requiring a certain sanitary commission to sign certain articles of incorporation
15 and file them with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation;
16 requiring the State Department of Assessments and Taxation to receive certain
17 articles of incorporation, mark the date and time of receipt on the articles of
18 incorporation, and issue a certain certificate of approval under certain
19 circumstances; providing that the name of a certain nonprofit organization and
20 certain trade names shall remain in the name of a certain sanitary district until
21 changed by a certain order under certain circumstances; providing that all
22 rights, property, and existing obligations of a certain nonprofit organization
23 shall become the rights, property, and obligations of a certain sanitary district;
24 providing that title to certain property shall be vested in a certain sanitary
25 district and no reversion or impairment of ownership rights shall be caused by a
26 certain conversion; providing that the rights of a certain creditor may not be
27 impaired without the creditor's consent under certain circumstances; providing
28 that a certain sanitary district shall have the powers and duties of certain other
29 sanitary districts; stating the intent of the General Assembly; providing for the
30 termination of this Act; and generally relating to the conversion of a nonprofit
31 organization established for operating a public water system in Calvert County
32 to a sanitary district.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article - Environment**

7 9-619.

8 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY CONTRARY PROVISION OF LAW, A NONPROFIT
9 ORGANIZATION INCORPORATED IN THE STATE AND ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE
10 OF OPERATING A PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM IN CALVERT COUNTY MAY PETITION THE
11 SECRETARY TO CONVERT TO A DISTRICT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

12 (B) THE VOTE ON A PETITION BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NONPROFIT
13 ORGANIZATION TO CONVERT TO A DISTRICT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
14 CONDUCTED IN THE MANNER PROVIDED FOR IN THE CORPORATE BYLAWS OF THE
15 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

16 (C) A PETITION TO CONVERT A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION TO A DISTRICT
17 SHALL CONTAIN:

18 (1) A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A VOTE OF THE MEMBERS AND SIGNED
19 BY THE OFFICERS OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION APPROVING THE NECESSARY
20 CHANGES OF BYLAWS, AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES, DISSOLUTION OF THE
21 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION, AND FORMATION OF THE DISTRICT;

22 (2) A PROVISION THAT DESIGNATES THE SERVICE AREA OF THE
23 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION AS THE SERVICE AREA OF THE DISTRICT; AND

24 (3) ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION THAT CONTAIN:

25 (I) THE NAME OF THE DISTRICT, USING THE WORD "DISTRICT";

26 (II) A STATEMENT THAT THE DISTRICT IS FORMED UNDER THIS
27 SUBTITLE;

28 (III) THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND TERM OF OFFICE OF EACH OF THE
29 INITIAL SANITARY COMMISSIONERS OF THE DISTRICT; AND

30 (IV) THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE DISTRICT IS CREATED.

31 (D) (1) ON FINAL APPROVAL OF THE PETITION BY THE SECRETARY, THE
32 SECRETARY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL FILE A NOTICE OF
33 CONVERSION WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION.

34 (2) ON FILING THE NOTICE OF CONVERSION WITH THE STATE
35 DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION:

1 (I) THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL CEASE TO EXIST AND
2 ALL ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL BECOME
3 THE ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE NEWLY ORGANIZED DISTRICT WITHOUT
4 FURTHER MEETINGS, VOTING, NOTICE TO CREDITORS, OR OTHER ACTIONS BY THE
5 MEMBERS OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION; AND

6 (II) THE BYLAWS OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL
7 BECOME THE BYLAWS OF THE DISTRICT UNTIL CHANGED BY AN ORDER OF THE
8 SANITARY COMMISSION OF THE DISTRICT.

9 (E) (1) (I) THE DISTRICT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY A SANITARY
10 COMMISSION.

11 (II) THE SANITARY COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF NINE
12 COMMISSIONERS WHO RESIDE IN THE SERVICE AREA AND ARE CUSTOMERS OF THE
13 PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM.

14 (2) (I) THE COMMISSIONERS, INCLUDING THE INITIAL
15 COMMISSIONERS, SHALL BE ELECTED BY THE INDIVIDUALS WHO RESIDE IN THE
16 SERVICE AREA AND WHO ARE CUSTOMERS OF THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM.

17 (II) THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL CONDUCT THE
18 ELECTION OF ITS INITIAL COMMISSIONERS.

19 (3) THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL SERVE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
20 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE BYLAWS OF THE DISTRICT.

21 (F) (1) THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL SIGN THE ARTICLES OF
22 INCORPORATION AND FILE THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION WITH THE STATE
23 DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION.

24 (2) THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION SHALL:

25 (I) RECEIVE THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION;

26 (II) MARK THE DATE AND TIME OF RECEIPT OF THE ARTICLES OF
27 INCORPORATION; AND

28 (III) ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FOR ANY ARTICLES OF
29 INCORPORATION THAT COMPLY WITH THIS SUBTITLE.

30 (G) (1) THE NAME OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION AND ALL TRADE
31 NAMES SHALL REMAIN IN THE NAME OF THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT UNTIL
32 CHANGED BY AN ORDER OF THE SANITARY COMMISSION.

33 (2) ALL RIGHTS AND PROPERTY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION
34 SHALL BECOME THE RIGHTS AND PROPERTY OF THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT AND
35 THE DISTRICT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL THE EXISTING OBLIGATIONS OF THE
36 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

1 (3) TITLE TO ANY PROPERTY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL
2 BE VESTED IN THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT AND NO REVERSION OR IMPAIRMENT
3 OF OWNERSHIP RIGHTS SHALL BE CAUSED BY THE CONVERSION TO A DISTRICT.

4 (4) THE RIGHT OF ANY CREDITOR MAY NOT BE IMPAIRED BY THIS
5 SECTION WITHOUT THE CREDITOR'S CONSENT.

6 (H) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE NEW DISTRICT
7 SHALL HAVE ALL THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF A DISTRICT AS PROVIDED UNDER
8 THIS SUBTITLE.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the
10 General Assembly that all property, assets, liabilities, duties, processes, permits, and
11 proceedings of a nonprofit organization that converts to a sanitary district under this
12 Act be continued as the property, assets, liabilities, duties, processes, permits, and
13 proceedings of the sanitary district until altered by the sanitary commission.

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June
16 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
17 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
