- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain nonprofit organization established for
- 5 operating a public water system in Calvert County may petition the Secretary of

- 1 (3) TITLE TO ANY PROPERTY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL
- 2 BE VESTED IN THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT AND NO REVERSION OR IMPAIRMENT
- 3 OF OWNERSHIP RIGHTS SHALL BE CAUSED BY THE CONVERSION TO A DISTRICT.
- 4 (4) THE RIGHT OF ANY CREDITOR MAY NOT BE IMPAIRED BY THIS
- 5 SECTION WITHOUT THE CREDITOR'S CONSENT.
- 6 (H) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE NEW DISTRICT
- 7 SHALL HAVE ALL THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF A DISTRICT AS PROVIDED UNDER

- 13 proceedings of the sanitary district until altered by the sanitary commission.
- 14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June
- 16 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 17 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
