	(2) "DISABLED VETERAN" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SERVED IN ONE OR MORE OF THE UNITED STATES UNIFORMED SERVICES AND HAS BEEN CERTIFIED EITHER BY THE SERVICE OR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
