1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Tri-County Council for the Lower Eastern Shore - Wicomico County -**
3 **Membership**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Tri-County Council for the Lower
5 Eastern Shore of Maryland; providing for the application of this Act; and
6 generally relating to the membership of the Tri-County Council for the Lower
7 Eastern Shore of Maryland.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 20B - Tri-County Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland**

2 2-101.

3 (a) The membership of the Council consists of:

4 (1) Five county commissioners of Somerset County as voting members;

5 (2) Five county commissioners of Worcester County as voting members;

6 (3) [Five] THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND FOUR county council members
7 of Wicomico County as voting members;8 (4) (i) Three municipal elected officials, one from each county,
9 appointed by their respective municipal corporations as voting members; or10 (ii) If the municipal corporations located within a county are unable
11 to choose a municipal elected official within a reasonable period of time, the Eastern
12 Shore Municipal Association shall appoint an elected municipal official to represent
13 the municipal corporations of that county;14 (5) Members of the General Assembly representing the region who have
15 a majority of their legislative district in the region as voting ex officio members;16 (6) Other members of the General Assembly representing the region but
17 who do not have a majority of their legislative district in the region as nonvoting ex
18 officio members; and

19 (7) The other commissioners as ex officio nonvoting members.

20 (b) (1) A voting commissioner listed under subsection (a)(1) through (3) of
21 this section may designate another commissioner or county administrator
22 representing the same county to vote by proxy on behalf of the voting commissioner
23 when the voting commissioner is absent from a meeting.24 (2) A voting commissioner listed under subsection (a)(1) through (3) of
25 this section shall inform the council director in advance of which other council
26 member the voting commissioner designates to cast a proxy vote on behalf of the
27 voting commissioner.28 (c) The bylaws of the Council may provide for additional private citizen
29 membership on the Council.

31 (a) A member who holds membership by virtue of the member's elected
32 position holds office only during the member's term of office.

33 (b) Membership on the Council does not constitute holding an office of profit.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be
2 construed to extend or apply to the membership of the Tri-County Council for the
3 Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland in office on the effective date of this Act, but the
4 provisions of this Act concerning the membership of the Tri-County Council for the
5 Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland shall take effect at the beginning of the next
6 following term of office for the elected officials sitting as members of the Tri-County
7 Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2006.
