1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Health Insurance Plan Revenue Stabilization Account - Fund**  
 3 **Transfer - Prince George's County**

4 FOR the purpose of ~~authorizing the Board of Directors of the Maryland Health~~  
 5 ~~Insurance Plan to appropriate certain funds for a certain fiscal year from the~~  
 6 ~~Maryland Health Insurance Plan Fund to the County Executive and County~~  
 7 ~~Council of Prince George's County for the operation of the Prince George's~~  
 8 ~~Hospital Center~~ authorizing certain funds to be transferred from the Revenue  
 9 Stabilization Account for a certain fiscal year to be used for a certain purpose;  
 10 making this Act subject to certain contingencies; and generally relating to ~~the~~  
 11 ~~transfer of funds from the Maryland Health Insurance Plan Fund~~ the transfer of  
 12 certain funds from the Revenue Stabilization Account.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
 14 MARYLAND, That:

15 (a) ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of § 14-504 of the Insurance Article, in~~  
 16 ~~fiscal year 2007 only, the Board of Directors of the Maryland Health Insurance Plan~~  
 17 ~~may appropriate \$6,000,000 by approved budget amendment from the Maryland~~  
 18 ~~Health Insurance Plan Fund to the County Executive and County Council of Prince~~  
 19 ~~George's County to be used for the operation of Prince George's Hospital Center.~~

20 (b) This Act shall be contingent on:

21 (1) ~~the County Executive and County Council of Prince George's County~~  
 22 ~~providing \$20,000,000 to the Prince George's Hospital Center to be used for the~~  
 23 ~~operation of the Prince George's Hospital Center; and~~

1           (2)       certification to the Board of Public Works by the County Executive  
2 and County Council of Prince George's County that the \$20,000,000 provided under  
3 paragraph (1) of this subsection has been expended, notwithstanding the provisions  
4 of § 7-311 of the State Finance and Procurement Article or any other provision of law,  
5 for fiscal year 2007 only, up to \$5,000,000 may be transferred from the Revenue  
6 Stabilization Account established under § 7-311 of the State Finance and  
7 Procurement Article by budget amendment to the Department of Health and Mental  
8 Hygiene for the purpose of providing a special fund operating grant appropriation to  
9 Prince George's Hospital Center.

10       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 June 1, 2006.
