A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 - St. Mary's County - Old**  
 3 **Carvers Heights - South Hampton Community Village**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to  
 5 extend the deadline by which the Board of Directors of Save the Village must  
 6 present evidence that a matching fund will be provided; and generally relating  
 7 to the financing of certain capital projects.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
 9 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by  
 10 Chapter 432 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004  
 11 Section 13(3)(i) Item (BI)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432**  
 15 **of the Acts of 2004**

16 SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

17 (3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the  
 18 Senate:

19 (BI)Old Carvers Heights - South Hampton Community Village.  
 20 Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the  
 21 amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors  
 22 of Save the Village, Inc. for the planning, design, construction,  
 23 repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of Old  
 24 Carvers Heights - South Hampton Community Village, located  
 25 in Lexington Park, subject to a requirement that the grantee  
 26 grant and convey an historic easement to the Maryland  
 27 Historical Trust. Notwithstanding Section 13(5) of this Act, the  
 28 matching fund may consist of real property or in kind

1 contributions, AND THE GRANTEE HAS UNTIL JUNE 1, 2008, TO  
2 PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE  
3 PROVIDED (St. Mary's County).....250,000  
4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
5 June 1, 2006.
