4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Baltimore City a holder of a certain arena license

- 6 from allowing a person under a certain age to remain in the licensed premises;
- 7 providing certain exceptions from the prohibition; establishing certain

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A HOLDER OF AN ARENA LICENSE
21 ISSUED BY THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR BALTIMORE CITY
22 FOR A PREMISES OTHER THAN A SPORTS STADIUM OR A FACILITY THAT IS OWNED BY
23 THE STATE OR CITY GOVERNMENT.

(B) AN ARENA LICENSE HOLDER OR AN EMPLOYEE OF AN ARENA LICENSE
 HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS TO REMAIN IN

THE LICENSED PREMISES UNLESS THE PERSON IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LICENSE
 HOLDER OR AN ENTERTAINER PERFORMING AT THE LICENSED PREMISES.

3 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO:

4 (1) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR LICENSE 5 SUSPENSION OR BOTH; AND

6 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, A FINE NOT 7 EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR LICENSE SUSPENSION OR BOTH.

8 (D) THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL ADOPT 9 REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 June 1, 2006.
