House Bill 100 Environmental Matters (Delegate Elmore)

Judicial Proceedings

Somerset County - State's Attorney - Salary

This bill increases the annual salary of the Somerset County State's Attorney from \$91,100 to \$98,000, beginning with the next term of office.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Somerset County personnel expenditures would increase by approximately \$4,800 in FY 2007 and by \$8,200 annually beginning in FY 2008. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The current annual salary of the Somerset County State's Attorney is \$91,100. Salary adjustments for local officials take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which for the Somerset County State's Attorney is December 2006.

Background: The salary of the Somerset County State's Attorney was last changed by Chapter 262 of 2001, when it increased from \$79,200 to \$91,100. **Exhibit 1** shows the annual salaries for State's Attorneys in selected Eastern Shore counties.

Local Fiscal Effect: Somerset County personnel expenditures for increasing the State's Attorney's salary would increase by \$4,807 for salary (\$4,025) and fringe benefits (\$782) in fiscal 2007, reflecting the seven-month period from December 2006 through June 2007. Annualized personnel expenditures would be \$8,240 for salary (\$6,900) and fringe benefits (\$1,340). The estimate assumes a constant fringe benefits contribution rate of 19.42% as advised by the county.
