6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Zoological Society, Inc. for the planning and design of capital improvements to the elephant facilities at the Maryland Zoo in Baltimore.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

This bill requires a matching fund that may consist of in-kind contributions. No part of the fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act.

8. Special Provisions

None.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Maryland Zoological Society, Inc. (dba The Maryland Zoo in Baltimore) is a non-profit organization that provides: (1) Conservation education services to Zoo visitors on-grounds and through community outreach; (2) Free admission and educational programming to Maryland school groups grades K-12 (public, private and home school students) through the Free School Admission Program; (3) Tourism revenue as Maryland's premiere zoological park and as a fun, family-oriented and affordable attraction; and 4) Critical conservation and research impacting local, national and international species conservation efforts.

10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

The Maryland Zoo Elephant Breeding Facility as a complete project will provide for the design, planning and construction of: (1) Upgrades to the current elephant barn; (2) Construction of a new elephant "trek" walking path, providing more room for exercise, and several "activity stations," including watering holes, a wallow, and an area for foraging; (3) A covered outdoor structure to provide shade in the summer and ensure that even on cold days, the elephants will be able to go outdoors for the mental stimulation and exercise they need; (4) Construction of a second elephant barn to separate cows and infants from the bulls; and (5) A variety of natural substrates for the elephants to walk and stand on, which reduces the risk of arthritis and foot problems.

Round all amounts to the nearest \$1,000. The totals in Items 11 (Estimated Capital Costs) and 12 (Proposed Funding Sources) must match. The proposed funding sources must not include the value of real property unless an equivalent value is shown under Estimated Capital Costs.
