9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)				
It is the mission of CHI Centers, Inc. to join with others to create conditions that allow all person with disabilities to have opportunities to participate in community life; to have choices in the pursuit of personal growth; to maintain positive relationships with family members, friends and neighbors; and to be afforded respect and dignity. CHI Centers accomplishes its mission by providing services and programs to adults with disabilities from Montgomery County, Prince George's County and Howard County.				
10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)				
The MacDonald Knolls renovation project will address the issues of accessibility, code violations and efficiency of building systems. Electrical, plumbing and mechanical issues will also be addressed. The facility was constructed in the early 1950s and minimal renovations have been made to the facility since its completion. The building is used for a variety of purposes including: day habilitation programs for adults with developmental disabilities, day care for children with special needs and their typical peers, a special needs preschool program and an evaluation and assessment center. Currently the licenses for these programs are at risk because the facility does not meet State and County building codes and is lacking in meeting the American with Disabilities Act's accessibility enforcements. Interior renovations are needed to increase the capacity of the facility to meet the demand for a waiting list that currently exists.
