Somerset County - Sheriff - Salary

This bill increases the annual salary of the Somerset County Sheriff from \$48,100 to \$60,000, beginning with the next term of office.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Somerset County personnel expenditures would increase by approximately \$8,300 in FY 2007 and by \$14,200 annually beginning in FY 2008. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The current annual salary of the Somerset County Sheriff is \$48,100. Salary adjustments for constitutional officers take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which for the Somerset County Sheriff is December 2006.

Background: The salary of the Somerset County Sheriff was last changed by Chapter 262 of 2001, when it increased from \$41,800 to \$48,100. **Exhibit 1** shows the actual fiscal 2005 salaries for sheriffs in selected Eastern Shore counties.

Local Fiscal Effect: Somerset County personnel expenditures for increasing the sheriff's salary would increase by \$8,290 for salary (\$6,942) and fringe benefits (\$1,348) in fiscal 2007, reflecting the seven-month period from December 2006 through June 2007. Annualized expenditures would increase by \$14,211 for salary (\$11,900) and fringe benefits (\$2,311) beginning in fiscal 2008. This estimate assumes a constant fringe benefits rate of 19.42% as advised by the county.
