6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$600,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland State Fair and Agricultural Society, Inc. for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a new exhibit building.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

This bill requires a standard match.

8. Special Provisions

None.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Maryland State Fair and Agricultural Society, Inc. is a private, non-profit corporation classified by the IRS as an educational organization 501-C-3. The Society is an agricultural and horticultural organization for the betterment of the conditions of those engaged in such pursuits. This is accomplished through competitions and programs for people of all ages throughout the year.

10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

The project includes the removal of the old two-story 4-H dormitory and cafeteria, which was built in the 1940's. The first floor of the old building was converted to exhibition space and is used for poultry and rabbits during the State Fair. The second floor is unusable due to poor access. The project would replace this building with a two-story building with access to the lower floor from the north at ground level and access from the south, due to the topography, also from ground level. The first floor will be used to house 4-H rabbits and poultry and will include restrooms and livestock offices. The second level will be used to house the Department of Natural Resources exhibits during the State Fair. Previously the DNR exhibits have been accommodated in a tent. The second level will also incorporate an area for a museum devoted to the History of the Maryland State Fair, which will celebrate 125 years at the 2006 State Fair.

The building will be located on the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium. The exact location on the fairgrounds will be just south of the existing small animal building and just west of the 4-H-Home Arts facility. The new building will consist of two floors of 4,000 square feet each. Once the project is approved by the Legislature, architectural and engineering plans would begin. Demolition of the existing facility would take place immediately with all plans, demolition and site work to be completed before the opening of the State Fair in late August. Once the Fair concludes on Labor Day, construction would begin and the schedule would call for completion by June 30, 2007. The estimated costs are approximately \$1.2 million the breakdown of which is enclosed. In addition to requesting funding from the State requests have also been made of Baltimore County but the Maryland State Fair and Agricultural Society, Inc. has made the commitment to provide the matching requirements of \$600,000.
