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#### 6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt to serve as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Olney Boys and Girls Community Sports Association, Inc. for the planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of improvements to the Olney Boys and Girls Club Community Park.

# 7. Matching Fund Requirements

The grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the matching fund may consist of real property. The fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act.

# 8. Special Provisions

Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement.

## 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Olney Boys & Girls Community Sports Association (OBGC), a non-profit organization founded in 1969, provide meaningful extracurricular sports programs to 7,000 children annually regardless of their socioeconomic background, race, religion, national origin or geographic location. OBGC emphasizes the physical and emotional development of children to encourage lifelong participation in sports activities and the enhancement of their self-esteem. OBGC also promotes the enrichment of family values and individual and community volunteerism.

## **10. Description and Purpose of Project** (3000 characters maximum)

In 2001, OBGC built and now successfully manages a Community Park on 118 acres in Olney, MD. Child participation has increased from 3,600 participants when the park was being planned in 1998 to 7,000 kids from all over Montgomery County and other parts of Maryland today. OBGC's mission is to provide children with extracurricular sports programs that emphasize physical and emotional development, build self-esteem and cultivate a lifelong interest in sports, health and teamwork in a safe environment.

While the OBGC Community Park is one of the finest youth athletic complexes in Maryland, there are a number of safety and accessibility issues that need to be addressed immediately and we just don't have the resources to accomplish them, including:

- \* baseball fencing to protect children and spectators from dangerous foul balls.
- \*permanent restroom facilities so we can remove dirty porto-potties that our parents and children must use. Kids are running through the busy parking lots to get to cars or one bathroom to avoid porto-potties,
- \* paved walking paths to allow grandparent, elderly, and handicap access to ball fields to watch the children play
- \* an emergency vehicle driveway for one part of the park to gain access when kids are hurt on the fields,
- \* a secured entry system into the park,
- \* fencing around several large and deep storm water management pond
