## 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

Victory Youth Centers, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to the creation of public/private partnerships for building youth centers in the State of Maryland which are intended to serve the recreational, social and athletic needs of youth in areas that are currently underserved or not all served with such resources.

### **10. Description and Purpose of Project** (3000 characters maximum)

Until very recently, the Montgomery County Conservation Corps, Wheaton-Kensington Youth Counseling Services and a private daycare provider resided in the buildings on the site. The site also contains a condemned school building. The tenants have been relocated so that the current buildings may be razed and a more modern building, for a more efficient use of space, will be erected. The new building is designed to be a one story structure and will incorporate the recent occupants and a new Victory Youth Center recreational facility. The facility will also include 3,500 square feet dedicated to youth with special physical and/or developmental needs.
