(Prince George's County Delegation)

**Prince George's County - Board of License Commissioners - Summons Served
by Inspectors
PG 325-06**

This bill authorizes the inspectors of the Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners to serve summonses for hearings and inquiries held by the board.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Authorizing summonses to be served by the alcoholic beverages inspectors of Prince George's County would not affect county finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law/Background: For the purpose of authorized hearings and inquiries, the Comptroller, boards of license commissioners, or the members of the boards, as appropriate, may issue summonses for witnesses, and administer oaths or affirmations. Generally, these summonses must be served by the sheriff of the respective jurisdiction, with a number of exceptions.

Inspectors of the boards of license commissioners of Baltimore City and Anne Arundel and Harford counties may serve summonses in their respective jurisdictions.

Additionally, in the City of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County, the police departments may serve the summonses in their respective jurisdictions.
