#### 6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State debt to serve as a grant to the Board of Trustees of The Accokeek Foundation, Inc. for the planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, and reconstruction of the boat dock at the Accokeek Foundation site in Piscataway Park.

## 7. Matching Fund Requirements

The bill requires a standard match.

#### 8. Special Provisions

Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement.

### 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Accokeek Foundation manages a portion of Piscataway Park in cooperation with the National Park Service. In addition to preserving the pastoral view from Fort Washington, Mount Vernon, and the Potomac River, the Accokeek Foundation operates a number of educational and public programs and maintains the site open to the public year-round. Programs include the National Colonial Farm, the Ecosystem Farm, the Native Tree Arboretum, the Bluebird Trail, and others. The project for Improving Visitor Access and Educational Facilities will provide regular visitor access from the Potomac River and is expected to increase visitation and contribute to the Foundation's presence as part of the growing heritage tourism industry on the Potomac.

### **10. Description and Purpose of Project** (3000 characters maximum)

Entire program includes replacement of Boat Dock damaged by Hurricane Isabel in 2003, enhancements to the Saylor Grove Pier, rebuilt by the National Park Service in 2005, new entrances to the Visitor Center and the National Colonial Farm, improvements to the Visitor Parking area, and a variety of demonstration projects in rainwater and wastewater treatment on site. Strategically, these improvements constitute the Accokeek Foundation's three-year "50th Anniversary Initiative." Other elements of that Initiative include the re-landscaping of the visitor entrance to the site, creating demonstration projects to handle rainwater more effectively, and completing the innovative wastewater treatment system that has been designed but not yet implemented. Together these improvements are expected to increase visitation to the park by 5,000 to 10,000 people per year over the next five years. They will also provide improved access to local citizens to the resources of the Park and the Potomac River.
