To contribute to charitable organizations which are organized for advancing education or science, providing relief of the health concerns facing women and particularly the poor, distressed or the underprivileged.

To acquire property to carry out the community outreach programs, activities and services provided by the White Rose Foundation and the Prince George's County Chapter of The Links, Incorporated. Programs include mentoring single parent female heads of households; providing health education programs for familes; and mentoring students. The property will provide a physical location for the Foundation with an office out of which its directors would operate and maintain the financial, program, and other administrative records of the Foundation. In addition, meeting space will be available to the community.
