Public Service Commission - Postemployment Restrictions

This emergency bill requires that one year must have passed after leaving service with the Public Service Commission (PSC) as the executive director, the executive secretary, or the director of a commission staff division before the individual may: (1) represent a public service company before PSC; (2) appear before PSC on behalf of a party to a proceeding; or (3) appear before PSC on a matter within PSC's jurisdiction.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The change is procedural in nature and would not directly affect governmental finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: In order to: (1) represent a public service company before PSC; (2) appear before PSC on behalf of a party to a proceeding; or (3) appear before PSC on a matter within PSC's jurisdiction, two years must have passed for a former PSC commissioner or the OPC People's Counsel, and one year must have passed for a former PSC general counsel or hearing examiner.
