The mission of the Eastern Shore Nonprofit Support Center is to provide comprehensive programs and resources to promote innovation and growth among the nonprofit organizations of the region.

The Eastern Shore Nonprofit Support Center will be operated by the Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore and will serve as an incubator facility for the nonprofit community of the region. The Center will be a facility where staff and volunteers from nonprofit organizations on the Eastern Shore can conduct meetings and programs, receive training, and have access to the same services provided to the for-profit business community by local chambers of commerce and business development centers. The Support Center will occupy approximately 5,000 square feet, be fully handicapped accessible and have ample parking for meetings and small conferences.
