## 6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. for the renovation and rehabilitation of Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts.

## 7. Matching Fund Requirements

This bill requires a standard match.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts, Inc. is a 501c(3) non-profit organization whose mission is to provide culturally diverse arts programs to the community. For 27 years MHCA has provided enrichment to the citizens of Annapolis, Anne Arundel County and surrounding counties through the visual and performing arts. MHCA offers an extensive selection of classes (20% tuition free to AA county public school students) and has an annual enrollment of 6,000. We are home to :Annapolis Symphony Orchestra, Ballet Theater of Maryland, Annapolis Chorale, Annapolis Opera and the Peabody Preparatory of Baltimore - Annapolis Branch as well as a community center with an 850 seat auditorium that annually hosts over 100,000 patrons.

10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

Maryland Hall occupies the former Annapolis Senior High School, built in 1932. The Board of Directors has dedicated itself to the renovation and restoration of this important community facility. The original 250 windows of various sizes have deteriorated and pose the following problems to students and patrons: leaking air infiltration, plaster wall moisture, no energy efficiency, plus sash, frame and lintel failure. Window failures pose a threat to facility users. MHCA is replacing 179 windows (138 completed to date) with a remaining 71 windows to be completed. Window replacement includes lead abatement and disposal of old windows, masonry repair, lintel replacement and the installation of new double paned, vinyl clad windows. MHCA has completed phases I, II & III of the project and will complete the remaining two phases over the next two years as funding permits.
