FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 1575 Economic Matters (Delegate Zirkin)

Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sunday Sales - Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur

This bill allows the holder of any class of retail off-sale alcoholic beverages license in Baltimore County to exercise the off-sale license privilege between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9 p.m. on the Sunday preceding Rosh Hashanah and the Sunday preceding Yom Kippur.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2006.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect Baltimore County finances.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: Unless otherwise specified, a retail off-sale license holder generally may exercise the off-sale license privilege from 6 a.m. to midnight on every day except Sunday. A holder of any class of retail off-sale alcoholic beverages license in Baltimore County may exercise the off-sale license privilege between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m. on the Sunday preceding Christmas Day and on the Sunday preceding New Year's Day.

In Baltimore County, a Class B and a Class C beer and light wine or beer, wine, and liquor licensee may sell alcoholic beverages at a bar or counter on any Sunday. In addition, a Class A beer and light wine or beer, wine, and liquor license holder may exercise the holder's off-sale license privilege on the two Sundays preceding Passover, if the privilege is not exercised on the two Saturdays preceding Passover, the privilege is exercised between 6 a.m. and 12 midnight, and sales are limited to alcoholic beverages that are "kosher for Passover."

Background: In 2006, Rosh Hashanah begins the night of Friday, September 22 and Yom Kippur begins the night of Sunday, October 1.
