6. Purpose of Bill				
Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$260,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Havre de Grace Maritime Museum, Inc. for the planning, design, construction, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of improvements to the Havre de Grace Maritime Museum located in Havre de Grace.				
7. Matching Fund Requirements				
This bill requires a matching fund that may consist of in-kind contributions and funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act. No part of the fund may consist of real property.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)				
The mission of the Havre de Grace Maritime Museum is to collect, document, preserve and interpret the maritime heritage of the Susquehanna River and Chesapeake Bay through dynamic exhibits, hands-on classes, preservation and restoration programs, and by providing research resources to the general public. The completion of Phase II of the museum building will support the museum's educational and preservation mandate by providing the requisite facilities to hold and conduct the museum's active programs - the CWBBS (Boat School), SFEC (Environmental Program), ongoing and developing historic and hands-on exhibits.				
10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)				
<p>Since opening in 2001, the Museum's audience and programs have greatly expanded. As a result, we need to complete and expand our facilities. As originally planned, the museum's ground floor would accommodate specialized program space, particularly the CWBBS (Boat School) and SFEC (Environmental Program). These programs are presently occupying 75% of the museum's gallery space. Hence we would like to move these programs to their own facilities on the ground floor; thereby allowing the museum to complete its main exhibition gallery to dynamically tell the story of the River and the Bay. Specifically, we are developing a new exhibit in celebration the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of John Smith's discovery of the Chesapeake Bay, entitled "A Step Back in Time- Life 400 Years Ago". The ground floor needs to be enclosed and fit out for its special use by the CWBBS and SFEC; which will also require the creation of a separate exhibition and event pavilion.</p>
