House Bill 96 (Delegate Elmore)

Environmental Matters Education, Health, and Environmental

Affairs

Somerset County - Treasurer - Salary

This bill increases the annual salary of the Somerset County Treasurer from \$44,300 to \$60,000, beginning with the next term of office.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Somerset County personnel expenditures would increase by approximately \$10,600 in FY 2007. Annualized personnel expenditures would increase by approximately \$18,100 beginning in FY 2008. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The current annual salary of the Somerset County Treasurer is \$44,300. Salary adjustments for local officials take effect at the beginning of the next term of office, which for the Somerset County Treasurer is December 2006.

Background: The salary of the Somerset County Treasurer was last changed by Chapter 262 of 2001, when it increased from \$38,500 to \$44,300. **Exhibit 1** shows the salaries for treasurers of selected Eastern Shore counties.

Local Fiscal Effect: Somerset County personnel expenditures in fiscal 2007 would increase by \$10,554 for salary (\$9,158) and fringe benefits (\$1,396), reflecting the sevenmenth period from December 2006 through June 2007. Annualized expenditures would increase by \$18,093 for salary (\$15,700) and fringe benefits (\$2,393) beginning in fiscal 2008. This estimate assumes a constant fringe benefits rate of 15.24% as advised by the county.
