The purpose of the bill is to provide Capital funds for the acquisition of land for the New Revival Center of Renewal for an Ex-Offender Re-entry Program. This program would prevent at-risk youth from entering the correction system, reduce the recidivism rate of ex-offenders and rebuild family structure. To accomplish these goals, the center would provide life skills training, job training, economic empowerment, counseling, food and clothing support and moral guidance. This center would serve approximately 1,500 clients annually.
