10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)				
The Eastern Baltimore County Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan proposes a wide range of improvements to the County's roadway and sidewalk network to enhance bicycle and pedestrian access. These range from roadway modifications to create bike lanes, extending sidewalks to areas without existing access, marking bike routes, and creating new multi-use paths. These facilities will help address the strong public demand for safe places to walk, jog, bicycle, skateboard, roller blade, etc. The proposed area will extend from White Marsh to Essex.
