House Bill 1207 (Harford County Delegation and Baltimore County Delegation)

Natural Resources - Hunting Wild Waterfowl - Harford and Baltimore Counties

This bill decreases the minimum distance, from 800 to 400 yards, that a person hunting wild waterfowl in the waters of Harford and Baltimore counties must be from shore while standing in water on the natural bottom, from a boat that is drifting or being sculled, or from a boat that is anchored.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill's changes could be handled with existing budgeted resources.

Local Effect: The bill would not directly affect local operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: By regulation, the Department of Natural Resources establishes an offshore waterfowl hunting zone. Within this zone, a person may hunt waterfowl while standing on the natural bottom, from a boat that is drifting or being sculled, or from a boat that is anchored. In most areas, a person must be at least 800 yards from shore. In specified waters, the minimum required distance is 400 yards.
