House Bill 1237 Appropriations

Finance

Department of Human Resources - Local Social Services Boards - Membership

This bill authorizes a local department of social services board to have up to 13 members, as provided by local law and enacted by the local governing authority. Each board must have at least nine members, however. It repeals as duplicative the provisions in statute already allowing this for the local boards in Baltimore City and Frederick, Garrett, Harford, and Montgomery counties.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Analysis

Current Law: The local department of social services in each county must have a board. Except as provided in five specified jurisdictions, the local board must be composed of nine members. The local board in Baltimore City and Frederick, Garrett, Harford, and Montgomery counties must have at least 9 but no more than 13 members, as provided for in local law and enacted by the local governing authority.
