6. Purpose of Bill				
Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Project ECHO, Inc. for the demolition of an existing homeless shelter, and the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of ECHO House.				
7. Matching Fund Requirements				
This bill requires a matching fund that may consist of in-kind contributions. No part of the fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act.				
8. Special Provisions				
No part of the proceeds of the bonds or the matching funds may be used for sectarian religious purposes.				
9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)				
Project Echo Inc. provides emergency shelter to the economically displaced men, women, and children because of the limited space in the existing shelter (It is a 60 year old farmhouse ) we routinely turn away individuals/ families in need of shelter, in the last nine months we have denied more than 150 request. The age of the house and the size of the rooms create other problems. The kitchen is so small that meals have to prepared elsewhere and brought to the house by car. There are no closets and we have a serious problem with mold. Privacy is non-existent and we have learned to live with the bugs. Our circulation is poor and the electrical circuits routinely short-out.				
10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)				
The project will allow for demolition of the existing shelter, construction of a new shelter ,parking area for up to eight vehicles and construction of a new tot lot for the children. It will also allow for pay-off of the existing mortgage of \$189,000.00. The new shelter will accommodate 35 people with the flexibility to expand to 40 if necessary. A commerical size kitchen will be included so that the residents can prepare their own meals , a study room for doing homework , large dining room and a private office for shelter manager . A classroom for conducting courses on parenting skills , budgeting, resume preparing and health and nutrition training ,
