Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 - Prince George's County -  
South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex

---

This bill changes the grantee, from the Advisory Committee Group for the South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC), in the South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex project in the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2006.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Changing the grantee of the project would not materially affect State finances or operations.

**Local Effect:** The bill would not affect the finances or operations of M-NCPPC.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

---

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** Chapter 445 of 2005 authorized up to \$150,000 in matching funds to the grantee for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of the South County Sports and Technology Learning Complex, located in Fort Washington.

**Background:** The current grantee is merely an advisory committee and has no decision-making powers. M-NCPPC owns the building where the project is located and operates the facility. Prince George's County owns the land on which the facility is located.
