6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay Council, Inc. for the planning, design, and construction of a program center at Camp Todd.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

Girl Scouts is the world's preeminent organization committed to the well-being of girls. Girls need a place where they can just be girls - having fun, making friends, and feeling safe. Girls need to discover who they are, and to like who they are - that's the prescription for becoming comfortable, confident women who will make the world a better place. Girl Scouts makes sure girls get the opportunity to grow through cutting-edge initiatives in the arts; community outreach and education; environmental awareness; health and wellness; literacy; leadership and self-esteem; science, technology, engineering, and math; and travel. Girl Scout camp is a building block in the development of successful and resourceful young women. At camp girls experience the great outdoors, which provides opportunities for growth, discovery, and leadership. Girls get the experiences and resources they need to make smart choices that will help them overcome challenges throughout their lives.

10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)

Camp Todd is a 65 acre camp located in Denton, Maryland on Williston Lake, a private lake owned by the Girl Scouts. The lake features its own small island. The capital improvements at Camp Todd includes the creation of a 5,000 square-foot program center for year-round use with a kitchen and dining room, multi-purpose space and sleeping quarters with shower room. Waterfront improvements include the construction of a towrope and raft to ferry campers to the camp island. With improvement, Camp Todd will become the Girl Scout Council's second licensed residential camp, allowing week-long programming.
