Authorizing the creation of a State debt to serve as a grant to the Board of Directors of St. Mary's Hospital of St. Mary's County, Inc. for the planning, design, renovation, expansion, repair, construction, and capital equipping of the behavioral health and medical/surgical units.

The grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act. Grantee is requesting 47.9% of \$1,591,131

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)				
St. Mary's Hospital is a full service acute care hospital located in Leonardtown, Maryland, which is the sole acute care hospital serving the population of St. Mary's County, Maryland, whose mission is to uphold its tradition of caring by continuously promoting, maintaining, and improving health through education and services while insuring fiscal integrity.				
10. Description and Purpose of Project (3000 characters maximum)				
The project will provide for the renovation of a portion of St. Mary's Hospital to create a safer and more functional environment for its locked Behavioral Health Unit and Psychiatric Day Treatment Program. This project has at least a 15-year life and the property is owned by St. Mary's Hospital. A portion of the Medical/Surgical unit, adjacent to the Behavioral Health Unit, will also be renovated to enhance patient care and incorporate relocation of beds, already open to use but not readily accessible on the unit due to the distance from the nurses' station. The total physical capacity of beds will be reduced by four beds.
