### 6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$1,000,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Irvine Nature Center for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of the new administration, classroom, and laboratory building for the Irvine Nature Center.

## 7. Matching Fund Requirements

This bill requires a matching fund that may consist of real property and funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act. No part of the fund may consist of in-kind contributions.

## 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (3000 characters maximum)

The Irvine Nature Center is a non-profit education organization dedicated to the preservation and conservation of natural resources in the Baltimore region of the Cheapeake Bay Watershed. Its mission is to inspire appreciation and respect for the natural world, increase awareness of environmental issues, and to encourage individuals to sustain Earth's ecosystems. Irvine offers over 500 environmental educations program sessions annually. These programs serve 16,000 students, teachers, and members of the public; attendees are primarily from Baltimore County and Baltimore City. One of Irvine's more significant programs is our annual Project Clean Stream; In partnership with Cheapeake Bay Trust, last year, over 1,200 volunteers removed 64,000 pounds of debris from local stream sits. Irvine operates a no entrance fee natural history museum with live exhibits that features 24 species of animals. Except for major holidays, the museum is open to the public year-round

## **10. Description and Purpose of Project** (3000 characters maximum)

Since 1975, Irvine has operated out of leased facilities located on the grounds of St. Timothy's School in Stevenson, Maryland. Due to the sale of approximately 1/3 of the outdoor classroom space and the expansion needs for the school, Irvine must relocate. The State of Maryland provide 116 acres for a new facility on Garrison Forest Road in Owings Mills, Maryland. Plans for the new Center include the construction of a 16,600 square foot facility with classrooms and exhibit space to accommodate a variety of educational program for children and adults. The facility will be built using recyclable materials and environmentally sustainable construction techniques that can serve as a model for home and business construction. The new faiclity will allow Irvine to significantly increase services to children and adults.
