Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class B-Conference Center License

This bill increases the annual fee for a Wicomico County Class B-Conference Center license from \$1,100 to \$1,500.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Wicomico County license revenue would increase annually by \$400 per Class B conference center license. At this time, there is only one Class B-Conference Center licensee in the county.

Small Business Effect: Potential minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: Wicomico County has a Class B (beer, wine, and liquor) Conference Center license for a business that has a minimum capacity of 500 persons and also has a kitchen, dining, and meeting space. The licensee may sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption to persons attending an event at the conference center.
