Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 920 - *Sales and Use Tax - Bulk Vending Machines*.

This bill increases from 25 cents to 75 cents the maximum taxable price for purposes of an exemption under the sales and use tax for a sale of tangible personal property through bulk vending machines.

House Bill 951, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 920.
