Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 1061 - *Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class B (B, W, L) (TSB) Restaurant-Service Bar Licenses*.

This bill authorizes the Baltimore County Board of Liquor License Commissioners to issue not more than three Class B (B,W,L) (TSB) restaurant-service bar beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) licenses in the Towson Commercial Revitalization District or the Loch Raven Commercial Revitalization District; specifies requirements for a Class B (B,W,L) (TSB) license and for a restaurant for which a Class B (B,W,L) (TSB) license is issued; and provides for the termination of the Act.

House Bill 1702, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1061.
