Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 1063 - *Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Transfers into Towson Commercial Revitalization District*.

This bill authorizes the Baltimore County Board of Liquor License Commissioners to authorize the transfer of not more than two beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) licenses into the Towson Commercial Revitalization District; specifies requirements for licenses to be transferred; requires a license that is transferred be converted into a Class B (B,W,L) (TCRD) license; specifies requirements for a Class B (B,W,L) (TCRD) license and for the restaurant for which a Class B (B,W,L) (TCRD) license is issued; and provides for the termination of the Act.

House Bill 1703, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1063.
