"Article – Public Safety

<u>1–301.</u>

(d) <u>"Commercial mobile radio service" or "CMRS" means mobile</u> <u>telecommunications service that is:</u>

(1) provided for profit with the intent of receiving compensation or monetary gain;

- (2) an interconnected, two-way voice service; and
- (3) available to the public.

(e) <u>"Commercial mobile radio service provider" or "CMRS provider" means a</u> person authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to provide CMRS in the State.".
