AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 707
(First Reading File Bill – Second Printing)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 16, after the second “Act;” insert “making this Act contingent on the enactment of certain legislation;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 9, after “**MANUFACTURER**” insert “**AFTER POSTING A BOND IN AN AMOUNT SET BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE MANUFACTURER**”; in line 11, after “**MANUFACTURER;**” insert “**AND**”; and strike beginning with “**;** **AND**” in line 13 down through “**BONDED**” in line 14.

On page 8, in line 10, strike “2007” and substitute “2009, contingent on the enactment of legislation during the 2008 or 2009 Session of the General Assembly that requires the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to license, regulate, and bond locksmiths, including a requirement for criminal background checks and fingerprinting of all employees of an entity that provides locksmith services as described in § 15–210.1(a)(3) of this Act. If legislation regulating locksmiths as described under this section is not enacted during the 2008 or 2009 Session of the General Assembly, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly”.
