AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 708
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “officers;” insert “providing that certain individuals holding elected office in Baltimore City on a certain date shall earn a certain service credit in the Baltimore City Elected Officials’ Retirement System; providing that certain individuals who leave office before a certain date shall receive a certain service credit; providing that certain individuals appointed to fill certain municipal office vacancies in Baltimore City shall receive certain service credit; providing that individuals holding certain elected offices in Baltimore City after a certain date shall receive certain service credit;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 23, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) This section only applies to an individual elected to a municipal office in the 2007 general election in Baltimore City.

(b) (1) An individual described under subsection (a) of this section who serves a three-year term of office as provided in Section 2 of this Act shall earn 4 years of service credit in the Baltimore City Elected Officials’ Retirement System for that term of office.

(2) If an individual described under subsection (a) of this section leaves office before the completion of the three-year term, that individual shall only receive one year of service credit or partial year of service credit for each year or partial year served before leaving office.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if an individual elected to municipal office in the 2007 general election in Baltimore City dies, declines or resigns from the office, is disqualified, is removed from office, or otherwise becomes unavailable, an individual appointed to fill the vacancy shall only receive one year of service credit or partial year of service credit for each year or partial year that the individual serves in the municipal office in Baltimore City during the three-year term.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any individual serving as an elected official for a municipal office in Baltimore City as a result of the general election in 2010, and any general election thereafter, shall only receive one year of service credit or partial year of service credit for each year or partial year that the individual serves as an elected official for a municipal office in Baltimore City.”;

and in line 24, strike “3.” and substitute “6.”.
