preceding an election until the 11th day after that election.

1 (b) Except for a late application under subsection (c) of this section, an 2 application for an absentee ballot must be received by a local board not later than [the 3 Tuesday] **15 DAYS** preceding the election, at the time specified in the guidelines.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2007.
