#### HOUSE BILL 16

1 (a) Registration is closed beginning at 9 p.m. on the [21st] **26TH** day 2 preceding an election until the 11th day after that election.

3 9–305.

4 (b) Except for a late application under subsection (c) of this section, an 5 application for an absentee ballot must be received by a local board not later than [the 6 Tuesday] **15** <u>10</u> **DAYS** preceding the election, at the time specified in the guidelines.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2007.
