8 (vi) The Sheriff's Office shall also have assistants at the 9 compensation provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City. 10 Provisions shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the office of the 11 Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles.

(vii) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have the same
 power with respect to the salaries of the Office of the Sheriff as they have under the
 city charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.

(viii) Employees of the Sheriff's Office, except the Sheriff, shall be
 selected according to the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2007.
