A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Sheriff’s Office – Appointed Positions**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum number of certain positions the Baltimore
4 City Sheriff is authorized to appoint; and generally relating to the Baltimore
5 City Sheriff’s office.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2–309.

15 (d) (1) (i) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive an expense
16 allowance of \$750 two times per year and a salary of:

17 1. \$79,300 in calendar year 2007;

18 2. \$84,600 in calendar year 2008;

1 3. The purchase and maintenance of other items
2 necessary to fulfill duties that currently are not furnished by the Baltimore City
3 Sheriff's Department.

4 (v) A deputy sheriff who uses a personal automobile is entitled
5 to a monthly automobile allowance at the same rate paid to other State employees.
6 Any Sheriff who is assigned a city-owned automobile may not receive the monthly
7 automobile expense allowance.

8 (vi) The Sheriff's Office shall also have assistants at the
9 compensation provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City.
10 Provisions shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the office of the
11 Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles.

12 (vii) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have the same
13 power with respect to the salaries of the Office of the Sheriff as they have under the
14 city charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.

15 (viii) Employees of the Sheriff's Office, except the Sheriff, shall be
16 selected according to the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2007.
