3 in Dorchester County an additional Class A beer license may be issued for any
4 premises licensed under a Class B [beer license], CLASS C, or Class D [beer license
5 or beer, wine and liquor] license.

6 (II) (2) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF 7 DORCHESTER COUNTY MAY LIMIT THE NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL CLASS A BEER 8 LICENSES THAT IT ISSUES PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 9–102 OF 9 THIS ARTICLE.
