#### AN ACT concerning 1

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# **Public Safety – Eyewitness Identification – Written Policies**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each law enforcement agency in the State to adopt written policies relating to eyewitness identification that comply with certain 4 5 standards by a certain date; requiring each law enforcement agency to file a copy of a certain policy with the Department of State Police by a certain date; 6 7 requiring the Department to compile certain policies and allow public inspection 8 of certain policies by a certain date; and generally relating to eyewitness identification in a criminal proceeding. 9

#### SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (A) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2007, EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT 4 AGENCY IN THE STATE SHALL ADOPT WRITTEN POLICIES RELATING TO 5 EYEWITNESS IDENTIFICATION THAT COMPLY WITH THE UNITED STATES 6 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE STANDARDS ON OBTAINING ACCURATE EYEWITNESS 7 IDENTIFICATION.

8 (B) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2008, EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT 9 AGENCY IN THE STATE SHALL FILE A COPY OF THE WRITTEN POLICY RELATING 10 TO EYEWITNESS IDENTIFICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.

11 (C) (1) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2008, THE DEPARTMENT OF 12 STATE POLICE SHALL COMPILE THE WRITTEN POLICY RELATING TO 13 EYEWITNESS IDENTIFICATION OF EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE 14 STATE.

15 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL ALLOW PUBLIC
 16 INSPECTION OF EACH POLICY COMPILED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2007.
