- 21 SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS
- 22 APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- 23 (F) (G) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE AN ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER
- 24 FOR INCOMPETENCE, MISCONDUCT, OR FAILURE TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF

- 26 (G) (H) A CHAIR SHALL BE SELECTED BY THE GOVERNOR FROM 27 AMONG THE ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS.
- 28 (H) (I) THE ADVISORY BOARD MAY ACT WITH AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE 29 OF EIGHT MEMBERS.

 26 GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR.

(B) THE REPORT SHALL SET FORTH ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE ADVISORY BOARD AND SUMMARIZE THE ADVISORY BOARD'S ACTIVITIES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
